

District council meeting of 31 May 2021

1. Determination of venue for the district council meeting

The district council unanimously approved the Cultural Centre in Moutfort as the venue for this district council meeting.

2. Opinion of the District Council – National emergency response plan

The district council has the opportunity to give an opinion regarding the national emergency response plan ("Plan national de l'organisation des secours", PNOS).

MZB advised that a meeting and a telephone discussion involving the Cabinet and Mr Bram Krieps (Head of the CGDIS Fire and Rescue Service (Centre d'Incendie et de Secours, Moutfort)) had taken place. These discussions served as the basis for shaping the Cabinet's opinion.

JJA supported the opinion, on behalf of "Déi Gréng". Moutfort is the centre of the Contern district, and thus appropriate as the location for the operations centre. If the private sector is being reimbursed the costs for personnel, then the public sector should be treated similarly.

EE recognised the major need for the operations centre in Moutfort.

MZB reported on a letter from Contern district council to the Minister for the Environment, Carole Dieschbourg, in which routing with direct access to the main road was being proposed to the Ministry. To date, the council has not received a response.

PW welcomed the opinion and the improved safety provisions being sought. He recognised an improvement and understood that the necessary adjustments regarding the financing need to be made, although he did not find the amount of the sum concerned justified.

3. Approval of income

Income totalling € 1,673,058.85 was unanimously accepted for the financial year 2021.

4. Announcements and councillor questions

MZB announced a working session of the district council on 7 June in Moutfort, where the Conti Bus concept was to be reviewed. On this point, the district council can collaborate actively on improving this service to residents. On 14 June, the same subject is being discussed with the committees involved.

MZB announced planned festivities for the Luxembourgish National Holiday. The precise proceedings are still being determined, having regard to the sanitary measures in relation to COVID-19.

EE asked about the drainage works in the Rue de Moutfort in Contern. TJ explained that these would not be starting before the collective company holiday period. MZB added that it was not possible to tackle this at present, due to the current shortage of materials.
