## Adjustment of the agenda

### Item 12 – Request for withdrawal (Mr Arrensdorf)

Mr Arrensdorf requests that item 12 be removed from the agenda.

He wishes to obtain technical clarifications (bridge, study costs, street level, possible subsidies, impact in the Natura 2000 zone, absence of prior meeting, absence of contact with the property owners concerned).

He specifies that he is not opposed to the project, but wants all elements to be clarified before voting.

The item may be placed back on the agenda at a later date.

The Council agrees that the project may be presented without a vote.

Mr Arrensdorf notes that there is no urgency, as the original project dates back to 2004.

### Item 13 – “Shared Space” project (Mr Eiffes)

Mr Eiffes requests the withdrawal of the item concerning the shared-space project, considering that the figures do not match those presented during the previous meeting.

Council decision: postponed to the next session.

### Item 9 – Withdrawal (Mrs Zovilé)

The applicant has withdrawn their application. The position must be readjusted.

Question from Mr Eiffes: can a call for applications be launched without an adequate position?

Unanimously accepted: item withdrawn.

### Statement by Mrs Zovilé

Before the official opening of the session, Mrs Zovilé makes the following statement:

– She specifies that Mr Loose and herself have continued to work on the ongoing files.

– Mrs Ansay has not returned to ensure follow-up of

her files.

- Presentation of upcoming projects in the different villages.
- She emphasises that political changes are underway and that coalition discussions are taking place between the other parties.
- She believes that normal day-to-day functioning of the municipality can no longer be guaranteed.
- She recalls that the CSV has always ensured stable governance in the municipality.
- Announcement of her resignation, submitted today to the Grand Duke.

She will carry out her duties until the appointment of her successor.

#### Agenda items

##### 1. Council information – Resignation of Mrs Stéphanie Ansay

Mrs Zovilé informs the council of Mrs Ansay's resignation, dated 15 May 2025, date confirmed by the ministry.

Mrs Ansay reads her resignation letter and provides clarifications regarding her absence since August, specifying that she has not been contacted since then.

Items 2 to 6 of the agenda are held in closed session

##### 7. Definition of school organisation

Presentation by Mrs Lena Wengen, chair of the school board.

Key points:

- Lack of space due to a growing number of pupils.
- Exclusively qualified staff (54 teachers, including 9 new).
- Awaiting completion of the second phase of the construction works.
- Classes currently too large.
- A total of 445 pupils.
- Five school buses required.

No questions.

Unanimously approved.

##### 8. Approval of the Social Office budget

Presentation of the budget and the functioning of the Social Office by Mrs Philo Gunther-Marx.

Key elements:

- Increase in municipal financial participation (population increasing).
- Significant impact of the "Wanteraktioun".
- Presentation of 2025 figures (until August).
- Efficient organisation of the service; appointments often available on the same day.
- No social grocery store, but cooperation with a food bank.
- Explanations regarding the role of the social inclusion assistant.
- Explanations on the REVIS system.
- Question from Mr Thomé regarding reference addresses: 28 people concerned, 4 will leave the

programme by the end of October.  
Unanimously approved.

Item withdrawn.

##### 10. Approval – Deed of sale

Purchase of a forest at €300/are.

Total amount: €13,965

##### 11. Approval – Sale agreement

Explanations by Mrs Zovilé:

The applicants wish to modify their construction plan. The original plan was no longer feasible due to the planned installation of a bus stop.

Unanimously approved.

##### 12. Approval of the budget and contract – Retention basin area (CR132)

Presentation by the engineering firm Micha Bunusevac.

Key points:

- In the case of 100% funding, the ministry may add elements to the project to avoid amendments.
- The Water Management Administration has given its approval for the budget.
- The vote concerns pre-financing, later covered by subsidies.
- Questions from Mr Entringer about the impact on the Wiltgen farm (types of rainfall, heavy vs. long-lasting).
- Questions from Mr Arrenschorf (overflow planning, impact on bridge, need for a Natura 2000 impact study, clarification of study costs vs. construction costs).
- Mr Axmann asks for the surface area concerned in order to identify the owners to be contacted.
- Conclusion: this concerns only the study phase; the construction works have not yet been budgeted. The resolution must be adjusted.
