Public Session

3. Briefing on the “Shared Space Contern” Project
Joel Pinto, Head of the Technical Department, presents a detailed overview of the Contern Shared Space project.

4. Shared Space Contern – Upgrading the Town Hall Square and Street Remodeling

The College of Aldermen recommends approving the Final Design (APD) for the upgrade of the Town Hall Square and the remodeling of Rue des Champs, Rue des Sports, and Op der Haangels in Contern for a total amount of €4,653,000 (incl. VAT), to be allocated in the 2026 budget and beyond.

The municipal councillors vote orally and decide unanimously to adopt the proposal of the College of Aldermen.

5. Shared Space Contern – Public Park in the Village Center

The College of Aldermen recommends approving the Final Design for a public park in the center of Contern for an amount of €1,810,000 (incl. VAT), to be allocated in the 2026 budget and beyond.

Following an oral vote, the proposal is rejected with 6 votes against and 5 votes in favor.

In favor: MZB, YL, JPDG, EM, NR

Against: SA, RA, EE, JJA, PT, DZ

6. CR132 Retention Basin – Budget Reallocation

The College of Aldermen proposes the following budget amendment: Additional costs of €214,000 will be covered by the final 2025 budget surplus of €1,122,640.55.

2025 Budget Change: +€214,000

New 2025 Credit: €234,000

The municipal councillors approve unanimously.

7. CR132 Retention Basin – Cost Estimate and Contract for Studies

The College of Aldermen recommends approving the cost estimate and the contract for studies regarding the retention zone at the CR132 level in the amount of €234,000 (incl. VAT), with the expenditure assigned to the aforementioned 2025 budget item.

The municipal councillors approve unanimously.

8. General Traffic Regulations – Temporary Amendments

The College of Aldermen submits the following recently issued temporary traffic regulations for approval:

October 2025 – Temporary regulation in Contern, Rue de Luxembourg

October 2025 – Temporary regulation in Moutfort, Am Woellemslach

October 2025 – Temporary regulation in Contern, Op Bricherpad

October 2025 – Temporary regulation in Moutfort, Rue Kiem

The Municipal Council approves unanimously.

9. Resignation of a Member of the Youth Commission

The College of Aldermen proposes to accept the resignation of Ms. Eve Entringer (effective October 4, 2025) from the Youth Commission.

The municipal councillors approve unanimously.

10. Information and Inquiries from Councillors

Yves Loose informs that the SIDOR committee has unanimously decided to increase the waste incineration tariff from €96 to €120 starting in 2027. The last increase was in 1994. No adjustment is planned for 2026, as the announcement was made too late to be included in the budget.

Marc Entringer reports that regarding the SIAS tender for waste transport, a bidder filed a lawsuit claiming the deadline was too short. Since vehicles could not be equipped in time, the court ruled in their favor and extended the deadline.

He also expresses regret over the lack of dialogue regarding the formation of a new coalition, noting that information is currently only available through the media. He emphasizes that even in the case of disagreements, communication should remain possible and all positions should be considered.

Pol Thomé asks about the number of members in the Youth Commission. Noe Rodrigues informs that it currently consists of 7 members.
