Before the meeting officially opened, the Mayor invited Mr. Yves Loose, who formally announced his resignation as Alderman, to speak.

Mr. Dali Zhu then proposed an amendment to the agenda: a vote to elect a new College of the Mayor and Aldermen. The Council approved this addition

by unanimous voice vote. The Mayor noted that this item would be handled during the closed-session portion of the meeting.

Additionally, Mr. Dali Zhu requested the removal of the item: "Permanent appointment of an employee for the Communication department". Following a

voice vote, the Council approved the removal with 6 votes in favor and 5 against.

In favor: SA, RA, EE, DZ, JJA, PT

The Mayor then officially opened the session.

#### 1. Resignation Announcement

The Mayor formally notified the Council of her resignation.

#### 7. Approval of the “Leitbild” Guiding Principles (Climate Pact 2.0)

The College of the Mayor and Aldermen proposed the adoption of the “Leitbild” (guiding principles) as outlined in measure 1.1.1 of the Climate Pact 2.0. The Council voted unanimously to approve these principles.

#### 8. Special Development Plan (PAP) Checklist

The College proposed introducing a mandatory checklist for all new Special Development Plans (PAP NQ). This list must be integrated into the final vote for any new PAP. The College is now tasked with providing this checklist to any party interested in launching a new development project. The Council approved this proposal unanimously.

#### 9. Implementation of “Bauchek” Building Standards

The College proposed a new quality assessment framework for municipal buildings (new builds and renovations) using the «Bauchek» tool from Klima-Agence. Key points include:

Assessment during both the design and delivery phases.

A commitment to meet 40 of 45 priority targets during design and at least 30 targets upon completion.

Results will be documented under Climate Pact 2.0 and the Nature Pact. The Council voted unanimously to implement these standards.

#### 10. 2026 Forest Management Plan Forester

Gil Jacquemoth presented the forest management plan for 2026. The associated budget will be voted on during the next Council meeting.

#### 11. Proactif Agreement (Amendment 3)

The Council unanimously approved Amendment 3 of the agreement with ProActif SIS Sàrl for the year 2026.

#### 12. Temporary Traffic Regulations

The Council reviewed several emergency temporary traffic measures enacted between October and December 2025 (covering Rue Edmond Reuter, Rue de Moutfort, and Soibelwee).

Inquiry: Councilor Eric Eifes asked about the status of the construction regulations for the works in front of the grocery store on Rue de Moutfort. The College committed to researching the matter and following up via email. The regulations were approved unanimously.

#### 13. Subsidies

Alderman Yves Loose presented a proposal to grant a subsidy of €32,021.50 to the Contern Tennis Club. The Council approved the grant unanimously.

#### 14. Burial Concessions

Three burial concessions presented during the session were unanimously validated.

#### 15. Validation of Revenue

The Council unanimously approved the statement of receipts totaling €70,105.19, covering various reimbursements, timber sales, hunting leases, and utility refunds.

#### 16. Councillor Questions and Announcements

Events: The Mayor confirmed that the Moutfort Christmas Market (Dec 6-7) is fully organized. However, due to the current political transition, “Merit Day” has been postponed. A public notice will be issued once the new College sets a new date. Mr. Yves Loose noted that the Communications department supports this delay due to current staffing shortages.

#### New Appointments:

Dali Zhu announced the results of the evening’s elections for the new College. Mr. Dali Zhu has been elected Mayor, with Mr. Pol Thomé as First Alderman and Mr. Jean-Jacques Arrensdorff as Second Alderman. The incoming Mayor thanked the outgoing College for their service and stated that the new administration is ready to tackle upcoming challenges with a focus on the future.

The Mayor declared the meeting closed.
